

Dojang Rules

- ◆ Always bow:
 - When entering or leaving the training area.
 - At the commencement and end of each class.
 - When instructed to bow by Instructor.
 - When finishing practicing with a partner.
- ◆ Listen to the Instructor and communicate respectfully. A loss of temper will not be tolerated. Instructors are to be treated with respect.
- ◆ Arrive at training prior to your class and be ready in full dobok (uniform).
- ◆ Whilst wearing the KMAA uniform students should respect the uniform and behave according to the standards of the Academy.
 - No smoking in the Dojang or in uniform at any time.
 - No profane language to be used in class.
 - No gum chewing in class.
 - Wear the correct coloured belt.
 - No jewellery to be worn in class. Stud earrings are exempt.
- ◆ When fixing your belt or adjusting your dobok, do not face your instructor; turn your back to the instructor out of respect.
- ◆ All students must have clean and short finger and toenails.
- ◆ Avoid talking whilst the Instructor is talking to the class.
- ◆ All classes start at set times. Students must be changed and ready to start the class.
- ◆ Practice discipline, especially while training. Complacency can lead to injuries.
- ◆ Always keep in mind that you are being trained in a dangerous art. Treat it with respect and above all, never misuse it.

Please note, a failure to meet the standards set and expected could result in a meeting with the Head Chief Instructor.
